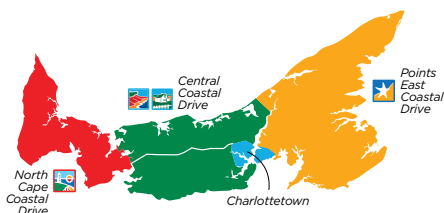

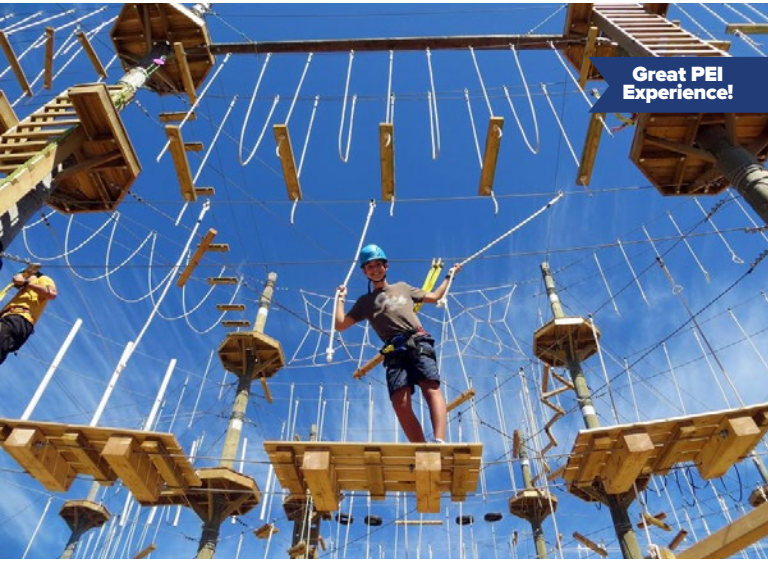


**A SPOOKY GOOD TIME**

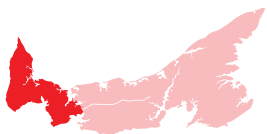
## NORTH CAPE COASTAL DRIVE

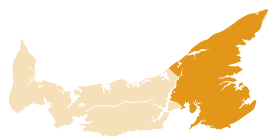

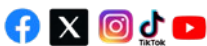

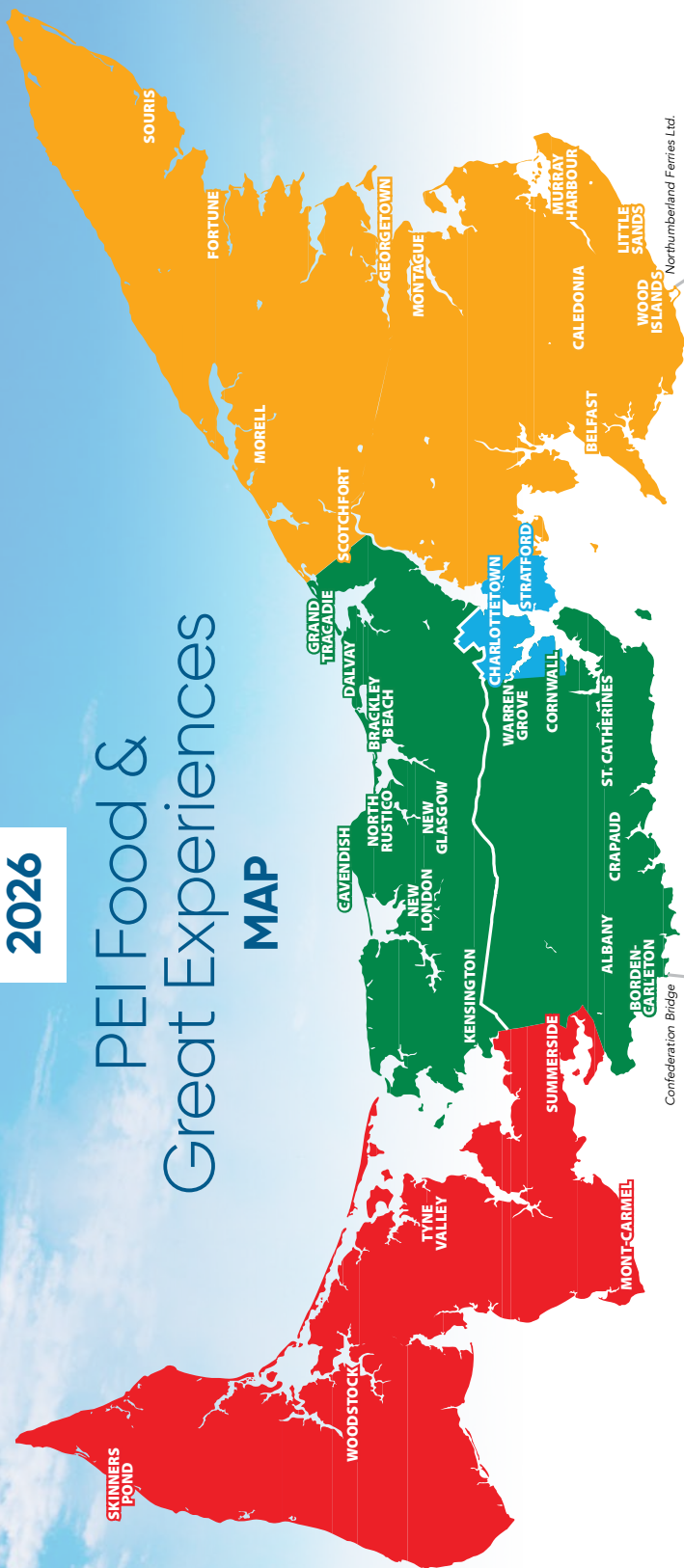
